

Peng Sun is an Associate Professor in the Decision Sciences area at the Fuqua School of Business at Duke University. His research interests lie primarily in the areas of mathematical theories and models for resource allocation decisions under uncertainty and dynamic optimization, with applications in marketing, operations management, economics and finance. At the Fuqua School, he teaches MBA courses in decision modeling and system dynamics, and a PhD course on dynamic optimization.

Professor Sun received his B.E. from Tsinghua University in China in 1998, and PhD in Operations Research from MIT in 2003. Currently he serves on the organizing committee of the 2011 INFORMS Annual Meeting, and as an Associate Editor at Operations Research, the flagship journal of the profession of Operations Research and Management Science.
