

Jonathon Cummings is an Associate Professor of Management at the Fuqua School of Business, Duke University. During graduate school he interned at Intel (studying collaborative software) and at Motorola (studying knowledge management). After completing his dissertation and post-doc at Carnegie Mellon University, he spent three years at the MIT Sloan School of Management as an Assistant Professor, where he received an NSF Early Career Award for his research on innovation in geographically dispersed teams and networks. His subsequent research focused on virtual teams in corporations as well as collaboration in science, and his publications have appeared in journals ranging from Management Science to Research Policy to MIS Quarterly. He is also faculty director for the Center for Technology, Entertainment, and Media (CTEM) at Fuqua, where he is initiating new research on technological disruption in knowledge-based firms.
