**Kevin Shang** is an Associate Professor of Operations Management at the Fuqua School of Business, Duke University. He is a member of Operations Management area. Professor Shang received his M.B.A. from University of California, Riverside in 1998 and Ph.D. from University of California, Irvine in 2002.

Prof. Shang's expertise is in supply chain management, production planning and inventory control, and logistics management. His research mainly focuses on developing simple and effective inventory policies for supply chains. He is also interested in problems related to the interface between operations and finance, and supply-chain sustainability issues. Professor Shang received First Prize award for Student Paper Competition of Manufacturing and Service Operations Management Society, INFORMS in 2001, and Honorable Mention award for Junior Faculty Interest Group Paper Competition, INFORMS in 2005 (with Gurhan Kok).

Prof. Shang's research has appeared in *Management Science*, *Manufacturing and Service Operations Management*, and *Operations Research*. He currently serves as Associate Editor for *Management Science*, *Manufacturing & Service Operations Management* and *Naval Research Logistics*. Prof. Shang teaches a core course, Operations Management, for the Full-Time and Executive MBA programs.
