## **Dean's Domain**

### **Alcohol Policy**

In order for the School to continue to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for all members of the Fuqua community, we must strictly enforce our policy on alcohol distribution and consumption, in accordance with North Carolina state laws. The alcohol policy prohibits the distribution and consumption of alcoholic beverages in any classroom, team room, seminar room or in Geneen or RJR auditoriums, unless special arrangements have been made with the MBA Programs Office and the R. David Thomas Center.

The Thomas Center staff abides by the laws of the state of North Carolina. Thus, students must abide by the following rules and regulations:

- Alcohol not purchased at the Thomas Center may not be brought onto the Thomas Center or Fuqua School property.

- All alcohol purchased at the Thomas Center may only be consumed on the property and in specific designated areas of the Thomas Center and Fuqua School buildings.

- All alcohol must be served by a Thomas Center employee.

- Guests without proper identification will be refused service.

- The Thomas Center staff has the right to refuse service to any student or his or her guests without proper identification.
