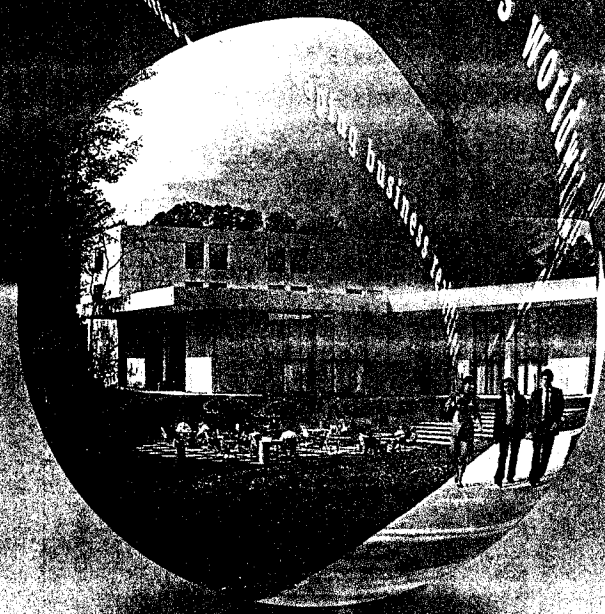

Campbell R. Harvey was named J. Paul Sicht Professor of International Business. An internationally recognized expert in portfolio management and global risk management, Harvey has taught at Fuqua since 1986.

Professor **Arie Y. Lewin** was named director of Fuqua's Center for International Business Education and Research, succeeding Professor Yair Aharoni, who retired in September 1995.

The American Marketing Association named Professor **Richard Staelin** as its Distinguished Marketing Educator for 1996. Staelin, who holds the Edward and Rose Donnell Professorship, also serves as academic program director of the Global Executive MBA (GEMBA) program.

Teacher of the Year honors in the daytime MBA program went to **Michael Bradley**, E.M. Kirby Professor of Investment Banking, and **Robert M. Dammon**, visiting associate professor. The two taught the Corporate Restructuring elective. Professor **Dan J. Laughhunn** was named Teacher of the Year by the WEMBA Class of '95, while **C.J. Skender** was honored by the EEMBA graduating class.

Associate Professor **James J. Anton**, who teaches Managerial Economics, was granted tenure by Duke University. Anton earned his doctorate from Stanford and joined the Fuqua faculty in 1989.

Professor **Wesley A. Magat** was the recipient of the 1995 NationsBank Faculty Award. Magat, an economics scholar who also serves as senior associate dean for academic programs, has taught at Duke since 1974.
